Submissions are now being accepted for this prestigious biennial award to be made at the 2012 CNSA Winter Congress.

Nomination process

Nominations may be made by any member of CNSA on behalf of another member; self-nominations are also accepted. A nomination may be for past or current contributions to cancer nursing and/or cancer control. To be eligible, nominees must be a resident of Australia and a financial member of CNSA.

Nomination submission requirements

The nomination submission package should include:

- The nominee's curriculum vitae (two pages only)
- An outline of the nominees work in the area of cancer nursing and/or cancer control (one page only in bullet point format)
- A summary of accomplishments (half- page only in bullet point format)
- Letters of reference from two people, with contact details, addressing any/all of the following questions (a one-page, bullet- point format submission is sufficient)
 1. How has the nominee contributed to cancer nursing and cancer control?
and/or
 2. What specific outcomes has the nominee achieved in cancer nursing and cancer control?
and/or
 3. Why should the nominee be selected for the CNSA Award for Excellence?
