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Purpose-built to:

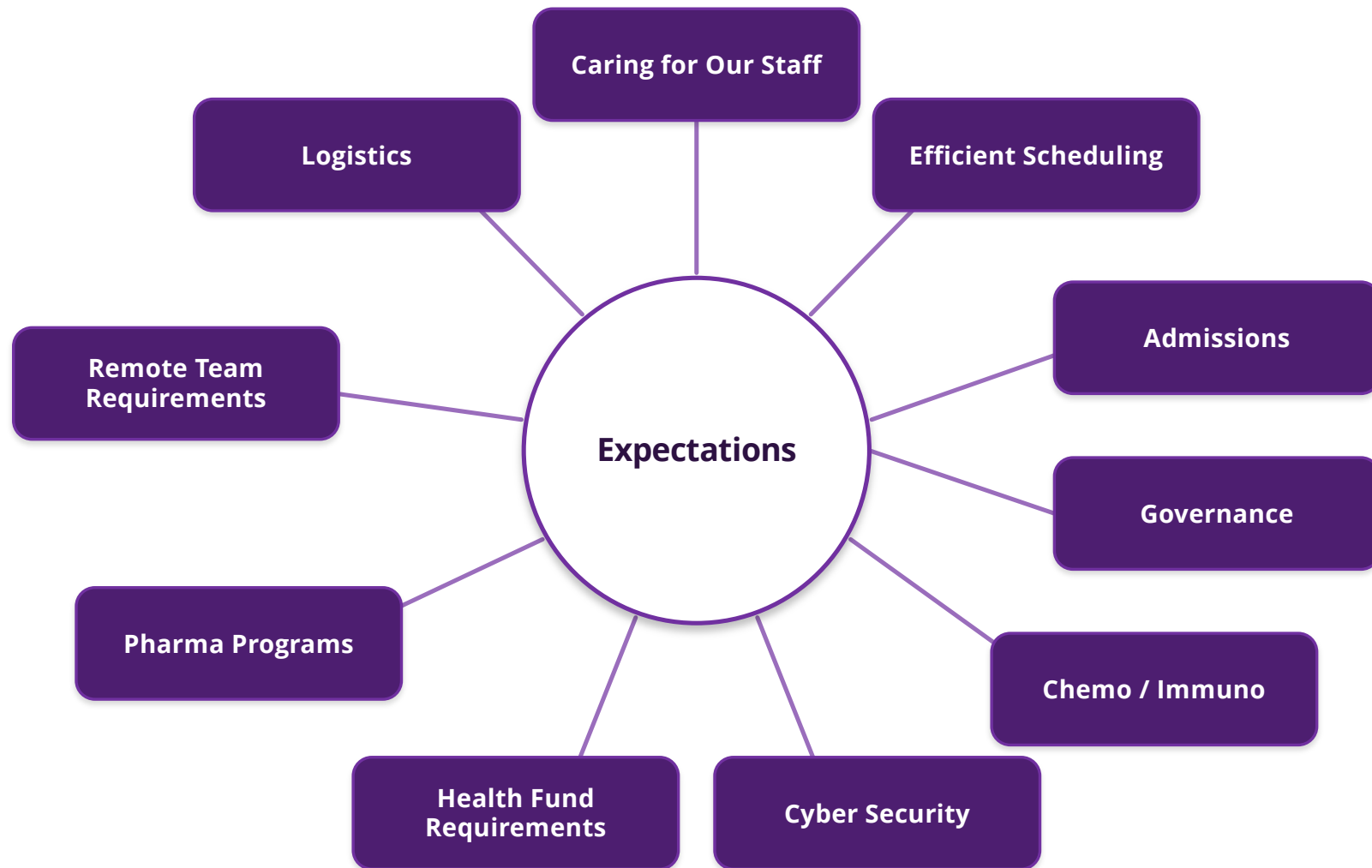
- **Deliver chemotherapy and immunotherapy infusions in the home**
- **Maintain hospital-level governance standards**
- **Operating nationally across most metropolitan and some regional settings**
- **Clinical leadership sits with nurses/pharmacists**

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Demand drivers – (ageing pop, chronic disease)
Supply constraints (workforce, hospital capacity)
Enablers – technology, policy, reimbursement
Preference shift – consumerism, experience,
Growth in informal caregivers / family care models
Changing expectations of digital-first consumers
Urbanisation + housing factors influencing aging-in-place

Patients report: Loss of energy → fatigue dominates everything

Loss of comfort → nausea, pain, neuropathy

Loss of independence → functional decline

Loss of control → anxiety, uncertainty

Loss of identity → hair loss, body changes

Burdens – extant and on carers

Fear of infection

Actual burdens of Tx

It is more than just convenient to have it at home



Clinical Governance Framework

- ACHS Accreditation
- Standardised clinical pathways
- Escalation and emergency protocols
- Adverse event monitoring and reporting
- Continuous audit and review
- Cold-chain and medication integrity
- Governance mirrors hospital expectations, layered with additional requirements



Patient selection

- Diagnosis and Rx
- Structured pre-treatment assessment
- Home environment assessment
- EHR and oncology management system
- Medical governance remains with treating doctor
- Nursing governance with chemo@home
- Pharmacist oversight



Digital & ICT Enablement

- Digital documentation in real time
- Secure communication between nurses, pharmacists, admin and specialists
- Scheduling and workload optimisation
- Clinical data audit and research
