REQUIRED EDUCATION, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- Registered Nurse and current registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia
- Tertiary Education qualifications in cancer nursing, ideally at Master level
- Minimum 5 years' recent clinical experience caring for people with cancer (solid tumour types)
- Strong interpersonal skills with demonstrated leadership and people management capabilities
- Ability to develop and deliver program and education content for the Nursing Program team and MCCN cohort

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Provide oncology nursing expertise to the McGrath Model of Care around treatment pathways and protocols for cancer nursing
- Work with the Nursing Program team to ensure consistency of information and support for MCCNs
- Provide specialist cancer nursing knowledge to the Nursing Program team and the greater McGrath Foundation team
- Provide clinical knowledge and support, through monitoring and mentoring, to MCCNs caring for people with cancer
- Apply expertise and experience to provide insights into the Nursing Program processes and provide feedback on opportunities to strengthen these processes
