## **REQUIRED EDUCATION, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:**

- Registered Nurse and has registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia
- Tertiary Education qualifications in cancer nursing, ideally at Master level
- At least 5 years' recent clinical experience caring for people with haematological cancers including myeloma and lymphoma
- Strong interpersonal skills with demonstrated leadership and people management capabilities
- Ability to develop and deliver program and education content for the Nursing Program team and MCCN cohort

- Provide haematology nursing expertise to the McGrath Model of Care around treatment pathways and protocols for haematological cancers, including lymphoma and myeloma
- Work with the Nursing Program team to ensure consistency of information and support for MCCNs
- Provide specialist haematology knowledge to the Nursing Program team and the greater McGrath Foundation team
- Provide clinical knowledge and support (monitoring and mentoring) to MCCN's caring for people with haematological cancer.
- Provide insight to the Nursing Program processes and provide feedback on areas of opportunities.
