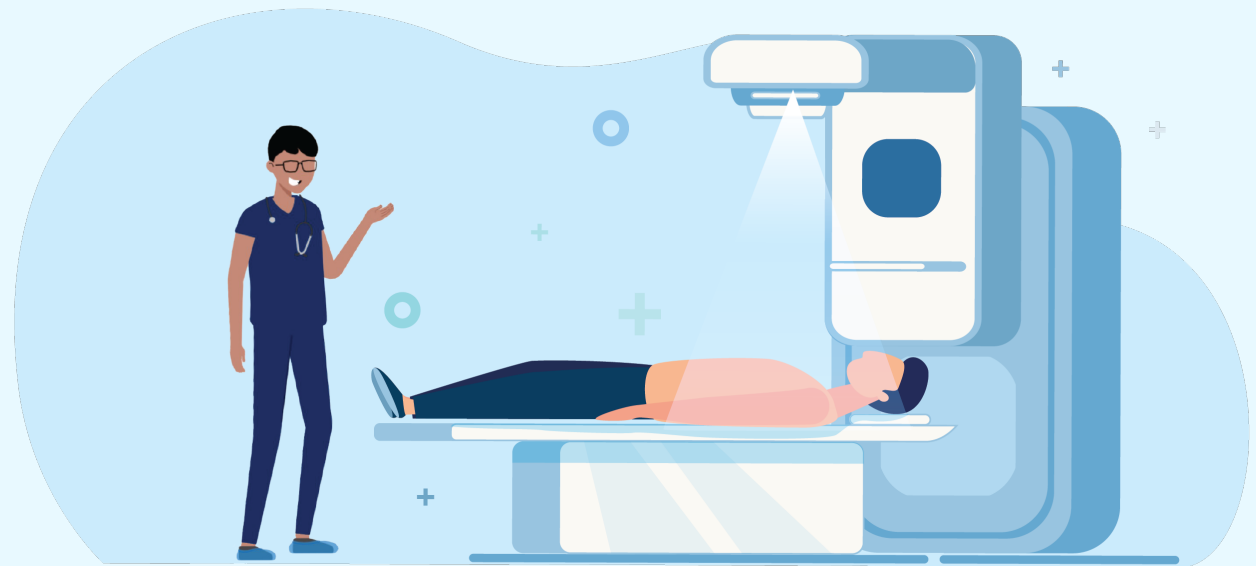

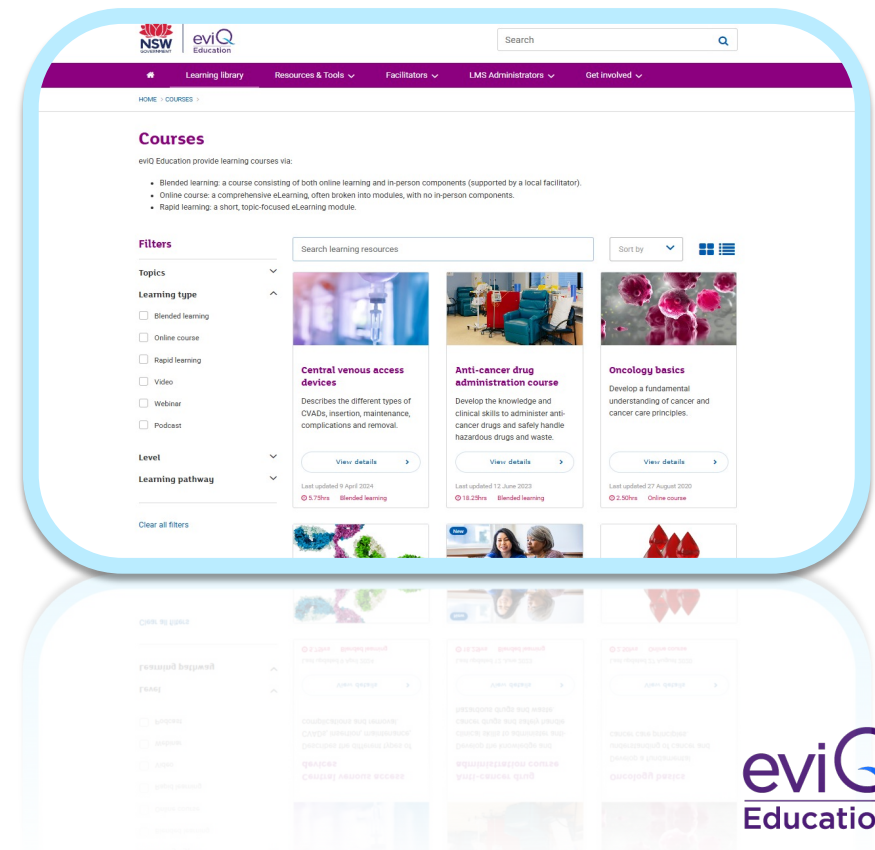

Aim and method

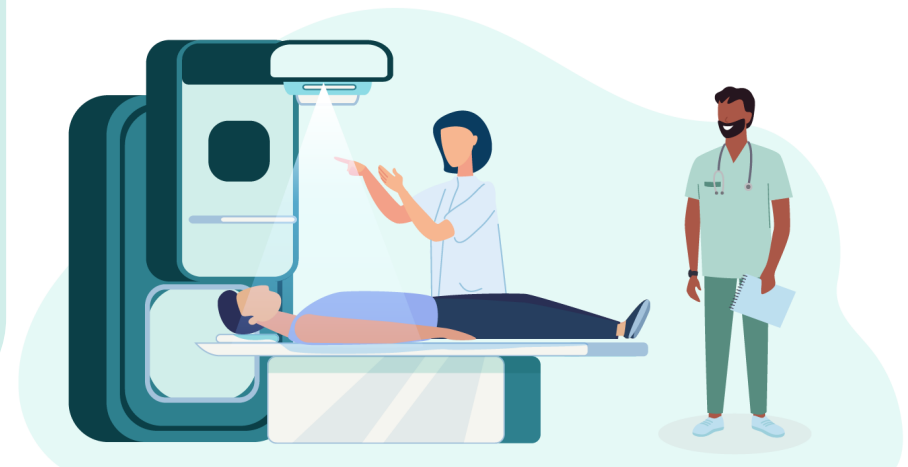


Aim: Build radiation oncology nursing knowledge and capability through the development of a standardised learning course.

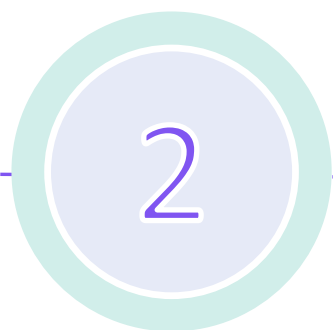

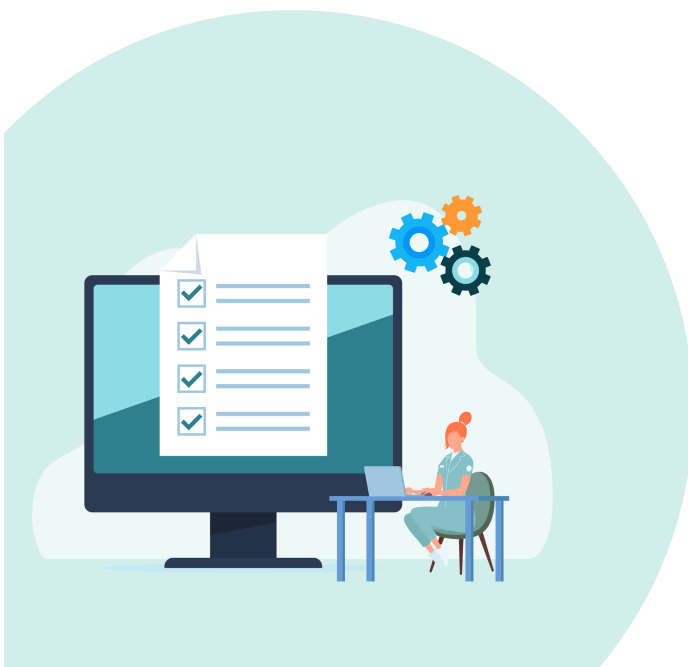
