

McGrath Foundation Position Description

Position: Nurse Clinical Lead – Melanoma and other Cancers

Group: Nursing Program

Synopsis: Provide support to the Nursing Program Team and the initial transition of Melanoma Nurses into the McGrath Foundation. This will involve supporting service mapping, the ongoing development and implementation of the McGrath Model of Care, including role development and mentoring of MCCNs in the care of people with melanoma. Following this transition period the Nurse Clinical Lead will support State-wide McGrath Cancer Care Nurses which will include other tumour streams.

Required education, skills and experience:

- Registered Nurse and has registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia
- Tertiary Education qualifications in cancer nursing, ideally at Master level
- At least 3 years' recent clinical experience caring for people with melanoma cancers and other tumour streams.
- Strong interpersonal skills with demonstrated leadership and people management capabilities
- Ability to develop and deliver program and education content for the Nursing Program team and MCCN cohort

Areas of responsibility:

- Provide melanoma and oncology nursing expertise to the McGrath Model of Care around treatment pathways and protocols for melanoma and other cancers.
- Work with the Nursing Program team to ensure consistency of information and support for MCCNs
- Provide specialist melanoma knowledge to the Nursing Program team and the greater McGrath Foundation team
- Provide clinical knowledge and support (monitoring and mentoring) to MCCN's caring for people with melanoma and other cancers.
- Provide insight to the Nursing Program processes and provide feedback on areas of opportunities.
